

Hawaii Prepares For Another Big Year

New attractions, activities and accommodation are set to grace the Hawaiian Islands this year, as the destination prepares itself for another big year for tourism.

Looking towards accommodation, 2019 will see the Waikiki Beachcomber by Outrigger unveil its newly restyled property, with new guest rooms. Waikiki's The White Sands Hotel is 'relaunching' this month following a full restoration, while The Sheraton Maui Resort and Spa's presidential Alii Suite has also been reimagined as part of the resort's recent guestroom renovations. Hawaii is also upping its culinary offerings this year, as the International Market Place partners up with Waikiki Trolley to launch the trolley company's first new line in six years: the Honolulu Dining Express.



HA's New Tastemaker

Chef Eric Oto has been named the newest member of Hawaiian Airlines' Featured Chef Series, which sees him creating the first-class menus on HA flights from Hawai'i to the U.S. Mainland. Chef Oto is also known as the chef de cuisine at The Kahala Hotel and Resort restaurant Hoku's.



The new foodie-focused route will run daily, with stops at highlighted eateries including Side Street Inn, Leonard's Bakery, Haili's Hawaiian Foods and Rainbow Drive-In. Attraction and activities around the island are also in for a boost, with the launch of new shuttle and eco-tour service Holo Haleiwa, which journeys from Waikiki to Haleiwa. Clients are also recommended to stop in at the newly renovated Moniz Family Surf store in Waikiki, which offers rentals and lessons or at Maui Ocean Centre, which is featuring a new *Humpbacks of Hawaii* exhibit. Other highlighted activities new to the islands include Kaanapali Beach Hotel's new schedule of on-property daily cultural activities which celebrate Hawaiian practices, as well as Kauai's The Lodge at Kukuila's intensive series, which empower guests to take their outdoor experiences on Kauai to the next level.

Honolulu Festival

The annual Honolulu Festival, which celebrates cultures from across the Pacific, is on in Oahu 08-10 Mar.
