## More Kiwis Say Aloha To Romance



Hawaii continues to be popular for romantic getaways, especially for Kiwis, says Hawaii Tourism Oceania's Darragh Walshe.

The STO has noted an increase in the number of Kiwi couples getting married in Hawaii with the first quarter statistics for New Zealand showing a 13% increase, year-on-year. "The Hawaiian Islands offer spectacular beauty along with an abundance of opportunities to share special moments," says Walshe.

Looking to the smaller islands, Lanai offers outdoor adventures for couples such as snorkelling at Hulope Bay's marine sanctuary and cliff hikes to Puu Pehe, while Molokai boasts cosy bed and breakfasts, charming towns and amazing sunsets at either Papohaku or Kapukahehu Beaches.

Maui has something to offer every sort of couple; from hikes up to Haleakala Crater and sunset cruises along the Kihei Coastline for the adventurous to shopping in Lahaina and culture at the Maui Arts & Culture Center for couples looking for something more relaxing.

Finally, clients bound for the Island of Hawaii can make the most of the destination's art, coffee and history scene.

Highlights include shopping and sightseeing at the historic Kailua Village and exploring historic small towns such as Holualoa and Hawi, which also boast art and coffee scenes. A road trip down Hamakua Heritage Corridor which offers old plantation towns, waterfalls and plenty of scenic detours is also recommended.
