

## HA Retrofitting B717 Island Fleet

Hawaiian Airlines has finished retrofitting the first of its Boeing 717 aircraft with an island-inspired interior cabin and new lightweight main cabin seating.

The new seats are 'engineering to ensure a maximum amount of personal space without compromising legroom or comfort', says HA COO Peter Ingram. Seatbacks offer a 'tablet table' designed for beverage service and use of a tablet device, and there's refreshed interiors with island-inspired colours, new seat covers, carpeting, curtains, flooring and new forward windows on some aircraft.

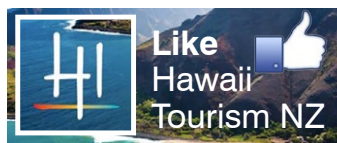
HA's entire narrow-body fleet, which operates inter-island flights, will be



retrofitted with the new enhancements by the end of 2015, providing consistency across the fleet which currently has five different cabin configurations.
