
A Local's Guide To Everything Chocolate

With cacao orchard tours, chocolate tastings and even the chance to make your own bar, Hawaii is a destination for those with a sweet tooth. In light of this, Hawaiian Airlines has put together





Highlighted stops in Hawaii Island include Barefoot Chocolatini, which offers farm tours, a Chocolate Bar Crawl, a chocolate ganache truffle workshop and private chocolate tastings.

At Hawaiian Crown Plantation and Chocolate Factory clients can tour the farm and then visit a chocolate factory to see how chocolate bars are made, while Hilo Sharks Chocolate offers classes in which clients can harvest cacao and make their own bar. late where clients can sample more than 20 types of dark chocolate and Lydgate Farm, which offers tours as well as chocolate bars, cacao shell tea, and sorbet and jam made from cacao juice. Princeville Botanical Gardens is also recommended for its Walking & Chocolate Tasting tour.

. . . More In Maui

In Maui, Hana Gold offers tours as well as tastings, while Maui Chocolate Tour sees clients make real home-made hot cocoa, as well as try and compare chocolates from around the world. Also highlighted is Sweet Paradise Chocolatier, which boasts chocolate concoctions with ingredients such as cinnamon, ginger, vanilla and chile.

. . . And In Oahu

Oahu has a plethora of sweet stops, but some of HA's favourites include the tastings at Madre Chocolate and the chocolate tour at Manoa Chocolate Hawaii where clients can meet the chocolate makers.

In regards to must visit shops, head to Choco Le'a which offers truffle-and-iced-coffee pairings, lonohana Estate Chocolate which offers Haleiwa chocolates and chocolate Thai iced tea and Padovani's Chocolates, which features hand crafted gourmet chocolates with flavours such as lemongrass, bourbon and Irish whisky.
