



# When Getting There Is Half The Fun

Oahu's North Shore is one of the world's surf meccas but it's not just the destination itself which is attracting tourists—it's the journey through plantations, cowboy-style towns and plenty of sweet treats.

Hawaii Tourism's Darragh Walshe has compiled a list of his favourite spots for clients travelling from Waikiki to the famed North Shore. First up on his list is a stop at Leonard's Bakery on Kapahulu Ave, where clients can grab some Malasadas for breakfast.

"The ones here are amazing," says Walshe, who adds there are lots of different types on offer.

Travelling on a little further, and perfect for those looking to stretch their legs (and grab a sweet treat) is the Dole Pineapple plantation, which offers a maze.

"It's a good stop if you've got family, and if it's a hot day you can get some Dole Whip [pineapple ice

cream]...it's iconic," adds Walshe. As the journey continues, clients will see the first sight of the famed North Shore waves, in the historic Haleiwa town, which Walshe describes as cowboy meets surfie. "It's almost like being out in the Wild West with some of the architecture; it's got a cowboy feel to it." Highlights of the town include its art galleries, coffee shops, food trucks and Matsumoto, which is known to have the best shaved ice in the Islands.

#### ... At The Shore

Once in the shore itself, Walshe recommends checking out famous surfing beaches Bonzi Pipeline, Sunset Beach and Waimea Bay (where he is pictured above). For those who would rather not surf, Sharks Cove is a great spot for snorkelling.

#### **Maui'd Under The Stars**
