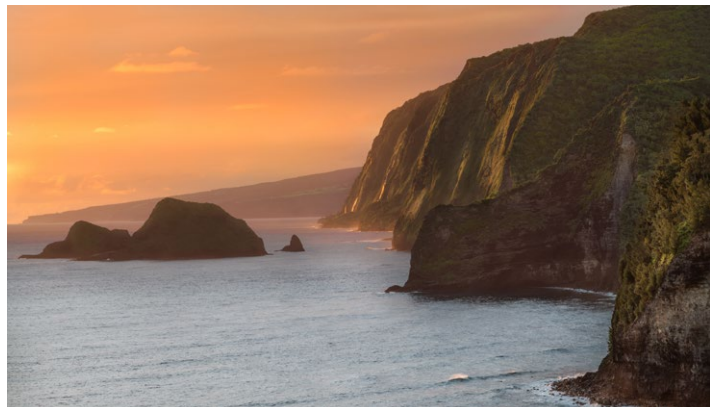


## Exploring The Island Of Hawaii

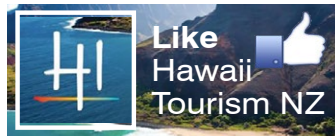
### ... Chasing Waterfalls

Also popular for tourists is Akaka Falls and Waianuenue Falls, which is also known as Rainbow Falls.

For clients who have 'been there done that', recommend a hiking or helicopter tour of the islands' Hilo, Hamakua and North Kohala district. Clients can opt for birding tours in the Hakalau Forests National Wildlife refuge, go zip-lining at Umauma Falls, hike Pololu Valley and take a helicopter tour over the North Kohala sea cliffs and valleys, pictured.
