

Hawaiian Islands Go To The Dogs



One of the hardest parts of going on holiday can be leaving your fur baby behind, but for those bound for Kauai, Maui or Hawaii Island a solution is here—as the humane societies are offering tourists the chance to take the shelter dogs on a field trip for the day.

The Maui Humane Society features a Beach Buddies Visitor Program, in which clients can take adoptable dogs out to the beach or go hiking for the day every Wed and Fri 1100-1600.

Unlike the other shelters, clients can pick which dog they would like to spend the day with here. A USD200 deposit is required, and it will be returned upon the return of the dog. ... Ka'ilio In Kauai

In Kauai, the Kauai Human Society will match clients with a suitable dog, which they can take out for a day for USD25, with all proceeds going back to the shelter. Clients can pick up a dog Mon-Fri 1100-1300 and must drop it off by 1700, excluding Wed. On weekends pick up is 1000-1200, with the dog to be returned by 1500. Kauai Humane Society also has a list of recommended dog friendly local destinations, including Moalepe/Kuilau Trail, Kapaa Coastal Path, Kekaha Beach and Kalapaki Beach. See kauaihumane.org

Alohilani Tree Pledge

Outrigger Race

Outrigger canoe racing, an iconic Hawaiian Sport, is set to be celebrated this Aug/Sep with the 2019 Queen Lili'uokalani Long Distance Canoe Race in Kona.

Held across five days (29 Aug-02 Sep), the race focuses on Hawaiian culture and history, with cultural events also on offer including Historic Walking Tours through Historic Kailua Village, multi-day Hawaiian Cultural Fair, International Paddlers Night, Paddling Talk Story, Torch Light Parade, and a traditional Hawaiian Luau.
