The Best Beaches In The Islands



Hawaii is home to some of the most famous beaches in the world, and Hawaii Tourism, has curated a list of the best spots to send your clients.

For Kauai-bound clients, the Poipu Beach Park comes in hot. It is one of the island's most popular beaches, it boasts crystal-clear waters.

Wrapping up the list are the beaches on the Island of Hawaii; Hapuna Beach State Recreation Area is known as one of Hawaii's finest swimming beaches, whilst the sheltered Kahaluu Beach Park is renowned for its excellent snorkelling.
