Guests staying at the lodge can book a full-day, private dive charter tour to the 'Coral Greenhouse' at the John Brewer Reef dive site.

With 20 sculptures of 'reef guardians' propagating coral submerged to a depth of around 18m, it is the largest MOUA installation.

New Reef Discovered

Schmidt Ocean Institute scientist have discovered a massive detached coral reef off Cape York in the Great Barrier Reef, said to be the first new reef to be discovered in more than 120 years. Do-nut Pass By


