Turtle Tips For Kiwis



It's turtle season in Queensland, and Tourism & Events Queensland has compiled a guide for agents helping their clients plan their next reef break.

The season runs Nov-Mar, with turtles coming ashore to nest Nov-Jan and hatchlings emerge Jan-Mar—plus the sunshine state is home to six of the world's seven species of sea turtles.

. . . Swim With Turtles

The Southern Great Barrier Reef offers numerous turtle-spotting opportunities, such as Heron, Lady Elliot and Lady Musgrave islands. Clients can opt for a day trip to Lady Musgrave Is. ex Bundaberg with Lady

Musgrave Experience, which offers scuba and snorkel tours to see the turtles; while Hervey Bay Eco Marine Tours which offers snorkelling and glass-bottom boat experiences.

For those visiting Cairns and Great Barrier Reef, Sunlover Tours offers snorkelling tours to Moore Reef;

while a Quicksilver Cruise from Port Douglas to Agincourt Reef visits the renowned Turtle Bay dive site which features an underwater observatory, semi-submersibles, snorkelling platforms and introductory dive areas. Frankland Island Cruises, has tours to the uninhabited Normanby Island; and in Townsville, clients can learn about conservation and see turtles with Gudjuda Tours.

... Baby Turtles

Those visiting Jan-Mar also have the opportunity to watch baby turtles hatching and taking their first steps toward the ocean.

Heron, Lady Elliot and Lady Musgrave islands are all southern nesting grounds for green and loggerhead turtles, where clients can take guided interpretive or self-led walks during nesting and hatching season.

More than half of the Southern Hemisphere's loggerhead turtle population nests at Mon Repos in the Bundaberg region, home to the East Caost's only ranger-guided turtle encounter.

TEQ says clients can also catch nesting/hatching season at Great Keppel Island, one of the most important rookeries for flatback turtles migrating from Torres Strait; as well as at Green and Fitzroy islands off Cairns. For more on the operators, click **HERE**.
