Get Lost In The Edgy Laneways of BNE

In between the new hotels, buzzing restaurants and greenery clients can uncover some of Brisbane's best, and underrated, laneways.

Over the past decade, the network of laneways has transformed into a place where the city's culture comes alive. So urge clients to pack their appetite, walking shoes and a sense of adventure and discover the narrow streets changing Brisbane's cityscape.

Burnett Lane (pictured) runs from George to Albert Sts. Suggestions include Brew Cafe & Wine Bar for coffee; brunch at Felix for Goodness; and a drink at American-inspired petite bar Super Whatnot, cocktail lounge Death & Taxes or tapas bar Alba Bar & Deli.

Eagle Lane is home to American-themed bar Brooklyn Standard and American-themed Fat Angel Sports Bar which streams live US sport and serves up American classics such as buffalo wings and tater tots.

Along Gresham Lane there's old school whisky bar, The Gresham, as well as a bustling mini food court of quick street feeds. Popular cafes are

California Lane offers an array of eateries such as the Japanese Shishou Sake Bar and Eats, and Italian restaurant Giardinetto as well as barbershop, bar and live music venue Born Creative Studio. The laneway also houses numerous boutiques and pop-up markets throughout the year.

Winn Lane has boutique shops such as Jess Blak and Uncommon Store, and the adjacent Bakery Lane offers cafes such as Cakes & Sht, The New Black, and Nom-Nom Korean.

Further south, Fish Lane is the place for adventurous foodies; dine on Italian at Julius Pizzeria or Asian at Chu The Phat and drink at gastronomic cocktail bar Maker or Saccharomyces Beer Cafe. Whitsundays Culture
